How do i get a spay voucher

Spay/Neuter Program Please read all instructions before filling out the application. Humane Solution's program is intended for pet owners in true financial need. Please help us to stay true to our mission of providing services to those who cannot otherwise afford spay-neuter services. Humane Solution uses NC HUD income guidelines to determine eligibility for our vouchers. Voucher/Household Income Guidelines: 1 Person - \$39,200 2 Person - \$44,800 3 Person - \$50,400 4 Person - \$56,000 5 Person - \$60,500 6 Person - \$64,950 7 Person - \$69,450 8 Person - \$73,900 If you receive public assistance, you qualify. If you have questions about income qualifications or are experiencing an unforeseen situation, please email us at info@humanesolution.org so that we may assist you. If you do not qualify for our program, you will be issued a full refund. Voucher turnaround time is typically within 2 days when the voucher and payment are submitted together. High Voucher application volume can affect this timing. *Disclaimer* Humane Solution reserves the right to deny any application without the need to disclose a cause. Humane Solution spay-neuter vouchers cover the cost of surgery only. Please check with your chosen vet about any additional requirements and other charges that may occur. The voucher holder is responsible for all additional charges, so please budget accordingly. Fill out an application on-line Click the Spay-Neuter Application button below. You must have an email address to use the on-line form. Each pet requires a separate on-line application. (*A valid email address is required to use the online application. If you do not have an email address, please see instructions to submit via mail.) Select a participating veterinary hospital. The list is available on the application or click here. Click the SUBMIT button. All fields must be filled out. The application will not submit if important fields are left blank. If you have filled out and successfully submitted your application, you will be taken to another page stating this. You may also pay from that page as well. Pay for your voucher on the voucher submitted page that you will be taken to after successful submission of your application. Online Payment Click the "Add to cart" button below for each voucher you wish to purchase. A pop-up window will appear with your shopping cart. You may increase the number of items by pressing the add to cart button again. If you have both dog and cat vouchers they will both appear in your cart. Click the "checkout with PayPal button" to go to PayPal and complete your purchase. If you want to pay with a credit/debit card, scroll to the bottom of the page and choose that option in PayPal. Voucher Pricing: \$45 for each cat \$60 for each dog If you wish, you may mail a check or money order to Humane Solution, PO Box 20712, Winston-Salem, NC 27120. *Mailed payments may take longer to process. Submit an application via mail if you prefer to apply for a voucher using a paper application: Mail it to Humane Solution, PO Box 20712, Winston-Salem, NC 27120. Your voucher will be mailed to you within 2 days of receipt. When we receive your application and payment, we will mail you a voucher card within 2 days of receipt. If you have not received your voucher after 10 days, please contact us. After you receive your voucher, make an appointment with the veterinary hospital you selected on your application. On the day of your appointment, take the voucher and vaccination records, if applicable. If you are unable to keep your scheduled appointment, please notify the veterinary hospital and reschedule your appointment. Vouchers typically expire after 2 months (please note the expiration date on your voucher after you receive it) and there is a \$10 fee to reissue expired vouchers within 6 months of the issue date. Please contact us if you need your voucher reissued or mail the voucher back to us with a \$10 check/money order for a reissued voucher. Full Re-issue/Refund Policy: Depending on the age of the pet, the vouchers typically expire after 2 months. There is an additional 4 month grace period after the expiration date when you can request a re-issue for a \$10 fee or a refund. After 6 months from the issue date your voucher is considered null and void. Your voucher fee will be considered a donation. We don't want to risk your pet going into heat or getting pregnant. If you need your voucher reissued, please return the expired voucher to Humane Solution along with a \$10 reissue fee within 6 months of the issue date. If the voucher is not for the same pet, please provide an application with the new pet's information. If needed, vouchers can be refunded by request only during the 6 month active period of the voucher. You will need to mail in your voucher and email info@humanesolution.org to ask for a refund. If you choose to donate your voucher fee for our "Spay it Forward" campaign, a tax-deductible receipt will be mailed to you. Humane Solution has instructed vets to refuse vouchers if you request declawing of your cat and ear or tail docking of your dog at the time of the spay-neuter surgery. Please realize that your pet will be undergoing surgery and will be under anesthesia. As with any surgery, there may be risks, depending on your pet's overall health. The vets may ask for additional tests before surgery, and in some cases, require those tests. Please discuss this with the hospital prior to your appointment and budget accordingly. Humane Solution spay-neuter vouchers cover the cost of the surgery, and vets that participate in our program may have individual requirements or charge additional fees over the cost of the voucher that are your responsibility to pay. Additional charges from the vet may include: Additional vaccinations Overweight pets Females that are in heat or pregnant Males whose testicles have not dropped (cryptorchid) Postoperative pain medication Exam or voucher fees If you can afford to pay more than the voucher cost, we can "Spay it Forward" to help other needy applicants. Any overage amount would be helpful. You can "Spay it Forward" using our regular donation button above. Did you know that in a single dog's lifetime, he and his offspring are capable of producing 60,000 dogs? With millions of pets euthanized each year due to overpopulation, sterilizing your pet is the honorable, responsible choice. We want to help all guardians of pit bull breeds and pit bull mixes keep their dogs safe and healthy. Starting with our hometown - STAMFORD, CT - we've created the SNIP program to provide essential services at a low, subsidized cost for qualifying guardians. We hope to open this offer to residents outside of Stamford, CT again soon. Until then, we do offer referrals for subsidized spay/neuter services to qualifying pet guardians of any pet, no matter the breed, and regardless of location of residence. Qualifying guardians are eligible for the following services on a sliding-scale basis: 1. spay/neuter surgery 2. vaccinations 3. microchipping If your pet in need of spaying/neutering, vaccinating, and/or microchipping your pet, please fill out an application. We'll get back to you to set up an appointment and to discuss which level of assistance you qualify for. Sorry, this program is not yet available to rescue organizations, shelters or foster homes. Established in 2007, Be the Solution is dedicated to preventing the cycle of suffering for unwanted pets living in shelters and on the street. Be The Solution works passionately to end pet overpopulation and euthanasia in our community by promoting and facilitating affordable spay and neuter surgeries. Our goal is to end pet overpopulation. Unwanted pets end up as strays or in shelters, and many are euthanized. Together we end this tragic cycle by preventing unwanted litters simply by getting our pets "fixed." Anyone that lives in Tallahassee, Crawfordville, Havana, Quincy or Monticello can receive a Spay/Neuter voucher. You do not have to be on public assistance to qualify. Yes. If you can afford to pay for your pet's spay and neuter surgery, please do so that we can provide the vouchers who others who cannot. However, if you need help, we are here for you. No, the vouchers are paid for by contributions from our partner veterinarians, Be the Solution donations and the client co-pays. Here's how it works: Our partner veterinarians in the community donate the bulk of the surgery cost. Each month, they spend their time, staff time and resources to provide spay and neuter surgeries for a fraction of what they normally charge because they, too, are committed to ending pet overpopulation. Please join us in thanking them every chance you get. Without their help, our program would not be possible. The next biggest part is paid by Be the Solution and the smallest piece is paid for by our clients who receive the vouchers. We have two co-pay structures. For residents who can provide proof of need, the co-pay is \$5 for a voucher to spay or neuter a dog or cat. For residents who cannot provide proof of need, the spay/neuter voucher co-pay is \$35 for a dog and \$25 for a cat. In both cases, the client co-pay cost is significantly less than the normal cost to spay and neuter a pet. To qualify for a PON voucher, you must also bring one of the following items: EBT Food Stamp Card Medicaid Card Unemployment Check Stub Disability Check Stub Previous year tax return demonstrating a one adult household with income less than \$25,000 per year. Previous year tax return demonstrating a two adult household with income less than \$40,000 per year. BTS spay and neuter vouchers are distributed at The Fix Thrift Store at 1208 Capital Circle SE, Unit D in Tallahassee on Tuesdays and Thursdays from 11 am - 1 pm and on Saturday from Noon until 3:00 pm. The store is located at the corner of Capital Circle and Apalachee Parkway in the Cross Creek Shopping Plaza next to Hopkins Eatery. Vouchers must be for your personal companion pet and you must bring your Driver's License or be able to provide an alternate photo identification card. A list of our partner veterinarians can be found below. Please be sure to thank them for their help. Without their time, experience and resources, this program could not exist. There are other services that our vets may require that are the responsibility of the pet owner: Rabies shot - All vets require rabies vaccinations. The price varies depending on which Vet you choose. Pain Meds - The price depends of whether it's a cat or dog, the weight and sex and which Vet you choose. Capstar for fleas - If your pet has a lot of fleas at the time of surgery, the Vet will administer Capstar. E-Collar (Cone of Shame) - If your pet is a stitch puller, an E-collar may need to be purchased to protect the surgery site. Be sure to talk to your vet about any fees for additional services so that you each have the same expectation. For questions about the voucher program, please call (850) 545-2043. BTS Spay/Neuter programs are limited to residents of Tallahassee, Monticello, Havana, Crawfordville & Quincy. Pet Care General Pet Care Due to COVID-19 and the potential delay in surgeries from our veterinary partners, it is advised to contact the vets listed below, ask what their fees are for voucher surgeries, and make an appointment with the one that you'd like to go to. Once the surgery appointment is made, you can contact us to set an appointment for purchasing a voucher. The Hayward Animal Shelter Volunteers offer low-cost Spay and Neuter Vouchers to Hayward residents. Vouchers are available for purchase at the Hayward Animal Shelter during open Shelter Hours. Vouchers are non-returnable, non-refundable, and cannot be replaced. Effective October 1, 2014, low-cost vouchers cost: Cats (male or female) \$75 Dogs (male) \$100 Dogs (female up to 40 lbs) \$150 Dogs (female 40-65 lbs) \$175 Dogs (female over 65 lbs) \$200 What is covered by the low-cost spay/neuter voucher? The voucher covers the following veterinary services: exam and spay/neuter surgery and, if applicable, pain medications, e-collar, and in-heat/pregnancy. If there are extra fees applied for additional services and medications required by surgery and/or authorized by the customer, then the customer is responsible for payment of these fees directly to the veterinary clinic. (For example, vaccinations, dental work, blood work.
